We are delighted to announce some significant enhancements to the Consult GEE NHS Human Resources service. In response to very useful feedback received from our customers, we have made the following changes:

New Section – Strategy & Research

We have introduced a new section on the home page of Consult GEE, including:

(a) IDS (Income Data Services) HR Case Studies

Access to over 80 of the IDS HR Case studies (4-6 pages each), which provide an in-depth explanation of how named organisations have dealt with specific HR issues. These case studies are fully searchable and can be browsed by topic or sector. New case studies are added regularly and are accessible to subscribers at no additional charge.

(b) Surveys and Reports

Consult GEE has expanded the selection of research reports available on the service. These now include over 25 reports from IDS, Pay Magazine and Consult GEE's own research conducted in conjunction with partners at conferences and events. The reports now include:

- Pay & conditions
- Pensions
- Salary surveys
- Software
- Working time & absence

(c) IDS Pay Benchmark

For an additional fee, subscribers can now access the IDS Pay Benchmark Service from their HR subscription. This service is a useful source of pay levels for scores of jobs and occupations. Benchmark your pay rates (for shop floor and office jobs) against named examples from Britain's leading employers.

Enhancements to News and Usability

a) Email Alerts

Email alerts have been improved to incorporate links to the Legal Timetable, and links to the Consult GEE Advice Line, helping subscribers to contact our experts more quickly. They can also manage the frequency of these emails from links provided.

b) Enhancements to the Home Page

In order to improve the presentation and usability of the home page, we have repositioned the news headlines. It is now even easier to access the news.
