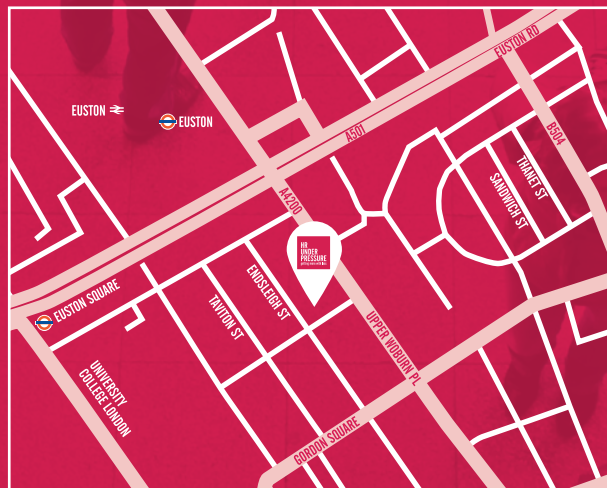
HR leaders in higher education and health coming together to share experiences, successes and learning.
